- **Early Enrollment postmarked no later than February 28, 2023**
- **Regular Enrollment postmarked no later than March 31, 2023**

We ask that applicants download the application form and instructions from www.sarasotafaces.org. **APPLICATIONS MUST BE PRINTED SINGLE SIDED.** If you have a mentor, ask your mentor to assist you with the post-secondary application. You can share copies of this material. The applicant should prepare a hand-written or typed submission. Applicants are required to answer **all questions on the printed form, attach all requested information (official transcript, original letters of recommendation, financial aid information, etc.) and sign both the form and the letter of agreement. Failure to disclose significant financial information will result in disqualification.**

All supporting documents must be received postmarked no later than the dates indicated above.

Faces of Accomplishment will award scholarships/financial assistance to applicants who meet the following criteria and who are selected by the Faces of Accomplishment, Inc. Scholarship Committee. **Indicate which Session you are applying for.**

_____ **I understand I am applying for EARLY Enrollment for a Scholarship available for the SUMMER SESSION of my schooling and the DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF THIS APPLICATION IS FEBRUARY 28, 2023.**

_____ **I understand I am applying for REGULAR Enrollment for a Scholarship available for the FALL SESSION of my schooling and the DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF THIS APPLICATION IS MARCH 31, 2023.**

1. Anyone accepted to (or already attending in good standing) a regionally accredited post-secondary education institution on a full-time basis (minimum 12 hours undergraduate) would be eligible for consideration.
2. Applications are limited to those who plan to attend 2- or 4-year institutions including technical/vocational institutions.
3. Each applicant must document financial need by submitting a FAFSA. It is not necessary for you to be eligible for government assistance for you to apply or receive an award.
4. This program is for high school seniors as well as those who may have received a Faces of Accomplishment, Inc. Scholarship in a previous year.
5. The applicant must be a full-time student and a year-round resident in Sarasota County.
6. A committee of qualified, experienced volunteers and board members will review applications and make recommendations to the Faces of Accomplishment, Inc. Board of Directors.
7. All awards will be “last dollar” scholarships to ensure any aid offered by a post-secondary institution is not reduced.
8. Letters will be sent to institutions stating that no government or institutional aid will be deducted or reduced from the applicant’s financial aid package as a result of receiving the scholarship.
9. Scholarships and/or financial aid will be paid directly to the institution to fund tuition, books and food plan. Unused scholarship funds will be returned to Faces of Accomplishment, Inc.
10. A complete, original application, including all items listed below (page 4) must be postmarked no later than March 31, 2023.
